National Youth Day this year is being held in Cheam, Surrey on Sunday 13th July.

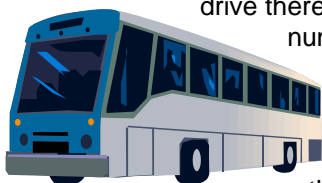
NYD is a one-day national korfball competition for children from all over the UK, with matches in all age categories from under 9 to under 19. This is the biggest event of its kind in the country and is enjoyed by players, parents, coaches and clubs alike.

Details of this year's NYD are still a bit sketchy at the moment, but it normally starts around 10:00am and goes on until 4 or 5pm. Games are played outdoors and each usually lasts about 20 minutes, with teams getting to play 5 or 6 games over the day. You get time to rest between matches, and there's often fun stuff to do as well, like shooting competitions.

Please put this date in your diaries now as we hope to take at least 1 Tigers team! We are also keen for as many parents as possible to come along and help with the team, and enjoy a day out in the sunshine (we hope!).
